The All-Ireland Rosary Rally will take place on Saturday 7th June 2025

The International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine at Knock will host the 40th Annual All Ireland Rosary Rally. A powerful day of prayer, reflection, and devotion that has united Catholics from across Ireland and beyond for four decades in honour of Our Lady.

From 4.30pm to 6.00pm, pilgrims will be invited to a picnic in the grass area behind the Basilica – an opportunity to meet and share with others. A Youth Conference for pilgrims aged 18 to 35 will follow in Saint John's Centre and run until 8.00pm, and this will be led by Father Luke DeMasi, Danielle Stephens, and Monsignor Steve Rossetti.

The day will conclude with a Pentecost Vigil and Healing Service, led by Basilica Leaders, Father Joseph Mary Deane CFR and Monsignor Rossetti, ending at 11.00 pm, Confessions will be available throughout the day, and all are welcome. On Sunday, 8th June, the Climb for Ireland will gather at the foot of Croagh Patrick at 10.00am, with Holy Mass celebrated at the summit at 12.00pm.
