Dublin Diocese Guidelines On Coronavirus COVID-19

***Regarding Mass celebrations and to minimise the risk of spread of infection the
 advice given is that the following should be suspended:***

Shaking of hands during the sign of Peace and on greeting and departure before and
 after Mass, the use of holy water fonts, the practice of receiving Holy Communion on
 the tongue and the use of communal vessels (people who are gluten intolerant should
 contact the sacristy before Mass for update on receiving from the Chalice). Eucharistic
 Ministers should use antibacterial hand wash before administering the Eucharist. By
 following the essential advice of both hand hygiene and respiratory hygiene, we will
 create a safer environment for all.
