- Church will open at 5.30pm on Saturday and 10.30am on Sunday
- Stewards will be on hand to show parishioners to their seat (Please wait to be shown to your seat and follow the steward's instructions. Do not change seats once seated)
- ❖ Please wear a facemask if you can, without causing health issues to yourself
- Please use hand sanitisers provided when entering the Church or bring your own sanitiser
- There will be designated seating areas for families to sit together as well as separate seating places for individuals
- ❖ Communion will be distributed to you in your seat by the Eucharistic Ministers. If you wish to receive please indicate this to the minister. You are asked to sit up on the seat and not to kneel to receive communion. Holy Communion will be brought to the Cherith.
- ❖ We have 40 set places to accommodate those at mass including the priest, ministers, stewards etc, <u>but not above 50 in total in the Church</u>. There are also 20 single seats in the Cherith from where parishioners can take part in the Mass on the TV
