From Pope Francis



“We are living in a time of trial. In the trails of life, you reveal your own heart: how solid it is, how merciful, how big or small. Normal times are like formal social situations: you never have to reveal yourself. You smile, you say the right things, and you come through unscathed, without ever having to show who you really are. But when you’re in a crisis, it’s the opposite. You have to choose. And in making your choice you reveal your heart.

In moments of crisis, you get both good and bad. Some move out to meet others - in new and creative ways, perhaps even without leaving their houses - while some others retreat behind defensive armour. The state of our hearts is exposed. In a crisis we have to revise and modify our roles in order to emerge from the crisis as better people.

This is a moment to dream big, to rethink our priorities - what we value, what we want, what we seek - and to commit to act in our daily life on what we have dreamed of. What I hear at this moment is similar to what Isaiah hears God saying through him: Come, let us talk this over. Let us dare to dream”
