ACI Zoom Meeting June 24, 2021 at 8.00 p.m. Fr Brendan Hoban to speak to ACI on Killala Diocese's three-year listening process 'Placing Faith in Hope' and Ireland's 'Synodal Pathway', to begin this year.

Fr Brendan Hoban, the diocesan co-ordinator for the western diocese of Killala, is faced with the necessity of moving decisively towards responsible lay parish councils and family-focused Mass and faith formation.
