



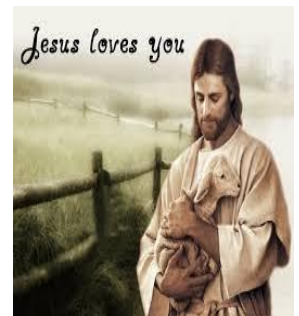
Corpus Christi Prayer
