We are currently in the process of claiming back Tax from Revenue using the **CHY3 Form** If you are and Irish Tax payer and donate \in 250 or more to a registered charity such as the Church, the charity can claim between **20**% and **45%** back in tax relief under the **Charitable Donation Scheme**.

For example if your yearly donation to the parish is $\notin 250$ - after the Tax Rebate is applied, your donation could add up to $\notin 362$ for the parish. If you receive a CHY Form from the parish, and are eligible for tax relief, please fill in the form and return it to the parish office. Thank you in advance for your support to our church.
