Mission and service: Pope Francis' vision for lay ministry in the Church (April 25 2023)

Two words sum up the essence of the presence of the lay faithful in the life of the Church: mission and service. This is Pope Francis' vision for the full and active participation of the lay faithful in Church life, which he presented in a speech on 'Lay people and the ministeriality of the synodal Church' during the plenary meeting of the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life.

This vision is not just about enabling lay people to do more – which would be merely a functional approach to their ministry – but about preparing them to participate intensely in ecclesial/church life and to bear witness to Christian values in the world.

"All ministries, indeed, are an expression of the sole mission of the Church, and they are all forms of service to others." Pope Francis said. (to be continued)
