Words of Pope Francis:

God is the first to love



“It is not us who first loved God. It's the other way around: “It is He who loved us first.” God sent us His Son. “He sent Him in the flesh” and the Son “humbled himself until death”. Jesus teaches us about what kind of attitude a Christian should have. It is all about “carrying on God’s own work in your own small way”: that is feeding the hungry, quenching the thirsty, visiting the sick and the prisoner.

Works of mercy, he said, pave the path of love that Jesus teaches us in continuity with God’s great love for us! We do not need great discourses on love, but men and women “who know how to do these little things for Jesus, for the Father.” “Our works of mercy, he said, are the continuity of this love.”
