How To Pray The Jesus Prayer While “Putting all our thoughts aside”

In The Way of a Pilgrim, a wise Russian Orthodox monk responds to the pilgrim’s deep desire to “pray without ceasing” with these instructions from St. Symeon the New Theologian:

Sit down alone and in silence. Lower your head, shut your eyes, breathe out gently and imagine yourself looking into your own heart. Carry your mind, that is, your thoughts, from your head to your heart. As you breathe out, say “**Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me.**” Say it moving your lips gently, or simply say it in your mind.

Try to put all other thoughts aside. Be calm, be patient, and repeat the process very frequently.

The stillness of this prayer is an inner stillness in which **God is unexplainably transforming us into the love of God in our nothingness without God.**
