Each year we have aimed to take about 150 sick pilgrims to our Lady's Shrine, cared for by a great voluntary team of doctors, nurses, chaplains, helpers and a wonderful group of 6th year students from 30 schools across the diocese. This has always been a hugely positive experience for the sick pilgrims, physically, emotionally and spiritually and provides valuable respite for their families and carers at home.

With spiralling flight and accommodation costs since 2019, the fare to Lourdes for 2024 has increased by €150 per person. Without the help of parishioners who contribute to the Associate Membership each year, the pilgrimage would not be possible. We are asking for your help with our fundraising. Any donation would be much appreciated. There are envelopes available at the back of the church for your donation.

The blue enrolment sheet containing the name of the Associates will be placed at the Grotto during the Pilgrimage and Mass will be offered.
