Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord (Tuesday 6th August)

Extract from a homily.

“There came a voice from the cloud, ‘This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.’”

This sounds like a rebuke to Peter: “Peter, be quiet. Be quiet. It’s not by your talking that you’re going to be saved. It is by me talking to you. It is by Jesus talking to you. It is by the Word of God that you are saved.” Psalm 46:10 says: “Be still and know that I am God,” or Habakkuk 2:20 “The Lord is in his holy temple. Let all the earth be silent before him. “ I feel that this voice from the cloud is speaking to the entire human race across every century. **“All of you, be quiet and listen to my Son. I love him. He is my glory. Listen to him and you will be saved.”** Learn to listen to God and to Jesus more than ever before. Feed on his word. Listen to what he has to say to you. From time to time, you might want to get away from the busyness of your life. Go find a mountain or whatever is good for you, forest, beach, but get alone and let God speak peace to your heart. Let him renew you. Let him restore you. Let him revive you so that you can serve him in others.
