Andrea Tornielli reflects on Pope Francis' remark that compassion 'helps us to see things better.'

What makes the world go round? Some might say the economy, others class struggle, others still curiosity, or the desire to embark on new ventures and experiments. Some might say love.

Pope Francis pointed to what he believed is the "engine" that makes the world turn. It is "charity expressed through compassion" that makes the world go round.

He said that compassion is not about offering help or alms to the needy "while looking down on them," but instead means bending down to truly connect with those on the ground, lifting them up and giving them hope.

Compassion is what Jesus exemplifies on every page of the Gospel. He does not remain indifferent to reality, but is deeply moved, allowing himself to be wounded by the stories and the needs of those he meets.
